

# Betta Care Sheet

1. Feed your betta what he can consume in five minutes or less. The food container will say feed twice a day, we recommend feeding the betta every other day. This will keep the waste level down for less frequent water changes.
2. In containers smaller than five gallons, a 50% water change needs to be done once a week. (Keep    of the water the betta is swimming in, put into a separate container. Rinse the gravel and wipe all algae off the sides of the bowl. Match the temperature as best as you can in the new water going into the bowl, touch and feel will work nicely. Slowly pour the old water and the betta back into the bowl.) \*be sure to add chlorine remover
3. Do not put the betta home in direct sunlight or over any heat source as this can alter the environmental temperature.
4. Do not put more than one male in any container as they are fighting fish and this will result in the death of one or both of the bettas.
5. A female should only be introduced to the male when there is a bubble nest present at the surface of the water, you should introduce two females at the same time so he can choose who he wants to breed with. He may kill one or both of them if he is not ready to breed. Remove female when the breeding is done.
